DESCRIPTION

Anti-slip HDPE granulate turns a standard floor coating into a durable anti-slip coating.

RECOMMENDED USE

NS100 Additive is intended to be added to 1K floor paints to produce a subtle non-skid surface, that is not harmful when falling on the floor and easier to clean than coarse antislip floors. Ideal for use in bathrooms. Mix with the required RUST-OLEUM paint prior to application.

THEORETICAL CONSUMPTION

Use 30g of NS100 per 1L of paint (for example 7200 Floorcoat PU) Product comes in a 75g packaging, which is ideal for a 2.5L packaging, for a 5L packaging, use $2 \times 75g$.

PRACTICAL CONSUMPTION

Practical usage depends on many factors such as type and amount of contaminants, shape of the substrate and material losses during application.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mix the granulates into the wet paint material and apply the coating with a roller or a brush (not by spraying), stir regularly to avoid settling of the granulates.

REMARKS

Particle size: 100 -200 µm.

SHELF LIFE

Minimum of 5 years from date of production in unopened cans, if stored in dry, well ventilated areas, not in direct sunlight at temperatures between 5° and 35°C.
