DESCRIPTION

Dispersion paint with quartz effect for outside and inside use.

RECOMMENDED USE

For protection of old deteriorated or cracked walls. Protection of concrete cell blocks against weather influences.

THEORETICAL CONSUMPTION

 $500\ g/m^2$ on even flat substrates. Minimum 1 kg/m^2 on structured substrates such as concrete cell blocks

PRACTICAL CONSUMPTION

Practical coverage depends on many factors such as porosity and roughness of the substrate and material losses during application.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Cell concrete blocks: prime with Martin Mathys Pegafix or Primer 44HS
Walls in poor condition: remove all old coatings or bad plasterwork. Sand/treat the wall with
a wire brush to remove all loose particles. Repair all damaged parts with a cement mortar
or Martin Mathys Pegacrete. Small repairs can be treated with a mix of Paracem Quartz
filled with dry sharp sand. All repairs should be primed with Martin Mathys Pegafix. Fill up
holesand seal joints or fissures with Martin Mathys Elastofill.

New walls/masonry: if possible wait 1 year before treatment. The substrate must be sufficiently dry and stable and no bleeding of nitric acid should be visible.

Brush dry and dust, then apply a coat of Martin Mathys Pegafix or Primer 44 HS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To ensure homogeneity, coating materials should be thoroughly stirred prior to use.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS

> 5°C, < 80% R.H.

APPLICATION & THINNING: BRUSH

Apply with flat brush.

APPLICATION & THINNING: ROLLER

Apply with a mohair paint roller. When the applied paint film is still wet, roll a again with a slightly wet plastic foam roller for a good and equal finish.

APPLICATION & THINNING: AIRLESS SPRAY

Not advisable

APPLICATION & THINNING: AIR-ATOMISED SPRAY

Possible with an opening diameter: 2 - 4 mm.
